RE: Response to RFI For University of Wollongong Western Building MOD 2 (SSD-8596-MOD2)

Further to your RFI in regard to the location of 57 trees, dictated by Condition D15 of MOD 1, as well as the request for additional correspondence from Sydney Water to support the need for the redesign of stormwater provisions, please find attached a revised section 4.55(1A) Statement of Environmental Effects, (**Attachment A**), as well as correspondence from Carndo (**Attachment B**).

Attachment A removes all aspects of the Section 4.55(1A) proposal that previously sought to address Condition D15 as part of the MOD 1 approval.

Attachment B confirms that further feedback from Sydney Water regarding the new flood training wall is not required. This is due to the fact that the proposed redesign is located outside the Zone of Influence of the DN500 watermain and thus, correspondence from Sydney Water is not required.
