**Marulan South Limestone Mine Continued Operations Project (SSD-7009)
Request for Additional Information**

Thank you for your letter dated 6 November 2019 responding to the Department's request for additional information in relation to the above project.

The Department is satisfied with the additional information provided with respect to the following matters:

- impacts on gas infrastructure;
- greenhouse gas emissions;
- Aboriginal cultural heritage; and
- Biophysical Strategic Agricultural Land.

However, the Department notes that landowner's consent for the lodgement of the application remains outstanding. Please keep the Department informed as to the status of Boral's negotiations with the Feltham Estate, noting that the assessment of the project cannot be finalised until landowner's consent is obtained.

The Department also notes that Boral has yet to finalise an agreement with Goulburn Mulwaree Council with respect to the widening and upgrading of Marulan South Road. As previously discussed, the Department is unable to finalise its assessment until Boral and Council reach mutually acceptable terms of agreement for the carrying out of the associated road works (including environmental impact assessment of those works under Part 5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*).
