Subject: Matters of National Environmental Significance - Eastern Creek Retail Outlet Centre, Rooty Hill Road South, Eastern Creek (SSD 10457)

Thank you for your email received on 11 November 2021, requesting comment on Matters of National Environmental Significance (MNES) under the Commonwealth *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act* 1999 (EPBC Act) for SSD 10457.

Environment, Energy and Science Group (EES) has reviewed the information provided and considers the significance assessments in the biodiversity development assessment report (Eco Logical, 4 August 2021) (BDAR) are inadequate for the following EPBC Act-listed species and communities:

- Cumberland Plan Shale Woodlands and Shale-Gravel Transition Forest CEEC (CPW) –
 present on site. Appendix E of the BDAR is an assessment of significance for CPW under
 the EPBC Act, but this is a 2012 report for a different proposal on site.
- Pteropus poliocephalus (Grey-headed Flying-fox) the BDAR states that this species is likely to forage over the site. Table 25 of the BDAR states that an impact assessment is required for the Grey-headed Flying-fox, however Appendix E does not include an assessment of significance for the Grey-headed Flying-fox.
