**M6 Stage 1 Project**

**Re: SSI 8931 - CoA A41 Identification of spoil haulage vehicles**

In accordance with the M6 Stage 1 (SSI8931) conditions of approval (CoA), all heavy vehicles used for spoil haulage must be clearly marked on the side and rear with the project name and SSI number to enable immediate identification by a person viewing the heavy vehicle.

Further to this, CoA A41 requires details of the SSI identification markings to be submitted to the Planning Secretary for approval and approved prior to the heavy vehicles being used for spoil haulage for the SSI.

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) have designed the attached identification markings (Attachment A). The size of the identification markings will be:

- 594mm x 200mm

The identification markings will be produced with a retroreflective background to enhance visibility in low light conditions and at night.

Placement of the identification markings will be on the sides and rear of each spoil vehicle, as per the CoA A41 requirement.

TfNSW is satisfied that the design and size of the stickers will enable the immediate identification of the Project by a person viewing the heavy vehicle.
