Morning Les,

As discussed, please see below response to the RFI from the DPIE dated 27th January 2021.

It is our understanding the construction period for Walla Walla Solar Farm will begin in April 2022. It is anticipated landscape works for mitigation purposes will commence in July 2022. It is understood works undertaken between April 2022 and July 2022 will be limited to ground level and focused on the substation area. Works will include earthworks, delivery and stockpiling of materials and foundations for the substation. The erection of solar panels will commence in July, coinciding with the commencement of landscaping works.

Planting in winter is generally recommended for revegetation work to ensure plant survival and establishment prior to the growing season. This is consistent with the advice provided by Holbrook Landcare Network. If landscaping is undertaken in July 2022 and ongoing maintenance is carried out in accordance with the considerations of Moir Landscape Architectures letter dated 21st January 2022, the planting is expected be established and capable of minimising views to the Project by March 2027.
