## Boral Berrima Cement (DA 401-11-2002-i) - Notification of New Supplier - RFI

I refer to your letter dated 22 March 2022 requesting further information on our suppliers processes to avoid PVC materials being processed in their biofuel plant. Boral can assure the DPIE that PVC contamination in any of our fuels is a significant risk to our process due to the release of chlorides which could impact our operations. For this and other quality reasons we have regular meetings and sharing of testing results. Furthermore, we also inspect our suppliers to ensure their processes are appropriate and assist in quality testing training for any new supplier.

In regard to Benedict Recycling we have visited their facility a number of times and we are comfortable with their approach to segregation and sorting waste streams to ensure clean timber enters their biofuel plant. Following receipt of your letter we passed this onto Benedict Recycling who has provided a detailed response and flow diagram which may assist in your understanding of their process (see attached).

Boral take our supply specifications seriously and have comfort with our current suppliers. We can arrange an inspection of the Benedict Recycling facility if you would like to understand all the steps that are taken to product their fuel.
