Dear Tim,

We thank you for your time to attend Royal Randwick Racecourse on 5 May 2022, to discuss the submission made by NSW on the proposed State Significant Development Application for Night Racing at Royal Randwick Racecourse (SSD 8706). For your records we have attached a copy of the submission made by NSW Police, to the back of this letter.

As discussed in the meeting, the Australian Turf Club (ATC) has always been, and will continue to remain willing for open dialogue with NSW Police in matters of operations that affect both parties.

On review of the submission made on 7 March 2022, the ATC would like to clarify the below points:

- ATC have no desire to run 'super events' whereby a daytime racing meeting would roll into a night time race meeting.
- The nomination of the proposed 16 night racing events is not in addition to the current racing calendar which conducts on average 45 race meetings per annum.
- ATC have submitted a draft Operational Plan of Management for Night Racing with SSD 8706 to advise on typical operational management measures for proposed night racing events. However, as discussed this document and the processes within would be subject to finalisation following approval of SSD 8706 and would require ongoing review and updating with the input from NSW Police.
- The submission for the Night Racing proposal identifies a number of mechanisms to minimise the lighting, noise and traffic impacts to the surrounding residents. This includes the use of user charges Police. Again these mechanisms are designed to minimise disruption to surrounding residents and are subject to change if it is deemed required.
- Finally the ATC acknowledge the requirement for controlling the sale, supply and consumption of liquor across all of its venues.


