I refer to your Response to Submissions document received 14 March 2022. The Department has consulted with the government agencies and with Goulburn Mulwaree Council (Council) on the document.

Please note Transport for NSW – Roads and Council's submissions will be received on 20 April 2022. Accordingly, I request you provide a response to the issues raised by the agencies who have provided advice on the Response to Submissions document.

In particular, I request you provide information to address the issues raised by Crown Lands, which details the process, timing and constraints relating to attaining landowner consent from Crown Lands.

I further note the following:

- Departmental policy requires evidence of the landowner's consent to accompany the development application;
- One parcel of Crown land falls within the extraction area and is central to any recommendation made by the Department; and
- There appears to be uncertainty regarding the timing and success of obtaining landowner's consent.
