Re: Uungula Wind Farm PA-9 – Request for Additional Information (RFI-42120664)

Uungula Wind Farm Pty Ltd (UWF) is writing in response to a request for further information, issued by the Department of Planning and Environment (the Department), on 10 May 2022.

The Department has requested the following Additional Information:

Please also provide the following:

1. *copies of the email correspondence with the non-involved resident along the route and with Dubbo Regional Council; and*
2. *confirmation that the request involves no changes to the table of vehicle types and volumes during the pre-construction phase provided on P2 of the original request for additional access points dated 27 October 2021.*

In relation to point 1, a copy of the correspondence with Dubbo Regional Council is provided at Attachment 1. In relation to the email correspondence with the non-involved resident, UWF sent an email to the resident and followed up with a phone call to discuss the extended access during pre-construction. UWF's record of this phone correspondence is provided below:

Matthew Flower spoke with the only non-involved resident on those minor roads. They were notified about the extension of the pre-construction truck and car movements with construction pushed out a bit beyond the April time we spoke of originally. He understood these things were required and raised no issues at all.

UWF confirms that point 2 above is correct. This was already confirmed in our letter dated 29 April 2022.

I would be happy to discuss further if required.

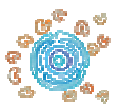

Good afternoon Chris and Peter,

As you know, last year the Department of Planning granted approval to UWF to access the Wind Farm site via Ungula, Wuuluman, and Ilgingery Roads, for the purpose of conducting pre-construction minor works. That approval expires tomorrow, 30th April 2022.

Today we've lodged a request to the Planning Secretary to extend this approval to 30th June 2022. We are still progressing with tender negotiations and detailed design, and at this stage we anticipate construction commencing in July.

Until then, we are seeking to continue using the additional access points for pre-construction minor works which are ongoing.

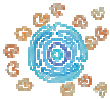
