

## **Eastern Creek REP Throughput Increase (SSD 11606719)**

### **Department's comments on Amendment and Submissions Report**

**22 November 2023**

In order to finalise the Department's assessment, additional information is required:

#### **1. General**

- Please clarify how many weighbridges are proposed at the new exit road to Honeycomb Drive. The ASR is inconsistent, in some places stating there would be one weighbridge while in other places it states there would be two.
- Provide further details of the upgrades to the existing internal roads, including information on the proposed road surface.
- Clarify the operating hours and days for the Site Workshop and Manufacturing and Maintenance Workshop.

#### **2. Waste Management**

- The Department considers the proposed increase in waste storage from 667,000 tonnes to 950,000 tonnes should be included in the SSD application rather than being sought via an EPL amendment. As such, please provide the following information:
  - justification for the need to increase stockpiling on site.
  - a copy of the Stockpile Management Plan discussed on page 25 of the Amended Proposal Description (Appendix A).
  - further details of the intended dimensions of internal and external stockpiles. Please also include a comparison between the existing and proposed stockpile dimensions and capacity (in tonnes).
  - details of how stockpile sizes would be managed and recorded.
  - details of any additional crushing, grinding and separating activity that would take place at the SMA and timber processing area as result of the proposed development.
  - details of how the presence of additional waste and any additional waste processing activities (especially at the SMA) have been accounted for in the existing air quality assessment documents.

#### **3. Air Quality and Odour**

- Please provide a copy of the Landfill Gas Management Plan referred to in the documents.

#### **4. Traffic**

- The Traffic Impact Assessment (TIA) Addendum refers to the original TIA as Version V05 March 2022. Noting the TIA provided with the EIS is Version V04 February 2022, please advise if there is a March 2022 version. If so, please provide this.

## **5. Water Management**

- Please clarify the proposed phased construction of the stormwater infrastructure. The civil design figure shows four phases, however it is not clear when each phase would be constructed compared to the proposed development stages.
