**University of Sydney - Engineering and Technology Precinct - Mod 2 (SSD-8636-Mod-2)
Request for Additional Information**

Regarding Engineering and Technology Precinct Modification 2 (SSD-8636-Mod-2), the Department requests that you provide a response to Council's comments (attached), and particularly provide:

- further information concluding whether the alternative flooding mitigation proposed is capable of the same performance as the previously proposed basin.
- detailed plans and sections, levels and proposed edges demonstrating that the amended design is DDA compliant and fit for use.
- details of changes sought to the landscape layout of all plazas (i.e. comparison plans showing approved vs proposed northern, southern and eastern plazas including detail of the Basin D removal), changes to plant species and any changes to the total number of proposed trees across the subject site.

You are requested to provide the information, or notification that the information will not be provided, to the Department by **Thursday 30 July 2020**.

The Department notes that the fees for the modification application are still outstanding. The application cannot be progressed to determination until the fees are paid. The Department requests that the fees be paid as a matter of urgency.

If you are unable to provide the requested information within this timeframe, you are requested to provide, and commit to, a timeframe detailing the provision of this information.
