Comments on social impact assessment requirements

It is suggested that the following requirements pertain to consideration of social impacts in the EIS:

Social

The EIS shall include a social impact assessment which:

- identifies any social impacts that are predicted to flow from changes caused by the project;
- considers in particular any concerns or aspirations that people may have about how the project might affect their surroundings, their way of life, their health and wellbeing, or their access to and use of infrastructure, services, and facilities;
- considers these social impacts (positive and negative) from the points of view of community stakeholders and how they expect to experience the project (i.e. using primary research and outcomes of engagement);
- investigates the extent to which any group in the community may disproportionately benefit or experience negative impacts from the project.
