**Liverpool Hospital Redevelopment (SSD- 10389)
Notice of Out-of-hours Crane Installation, Condition C5(d)**

I refer to your notification to erect the main Tower crane at the Liverpool Hospital outside of the prescribed construction hours, submitted to the Planning Secretary in accordance with condition C5(d), Schedule 2 of the project Development Consent for the Liverpool Hospital Redevelopment (SSD-10389).

I note that the notification:

- indicates the intention to carry out crane erection out of hours works from 5am to 7pm on 14 May 2022, and 7am to 7pm on 15 May 2022;
- comprised a letter, prepared by Lendlease Building, detailing the scope of works involved for the erection of the tower crane;
- was submitted to the Planning Secretary more than seven (7) days prior to the out of hours works occurring;
- confirms that local resident notification shall take place at least seven (7) days prior to the works occurring; and
- provides contingency dates should inclement weather prevent the works from occurring as originally proposed. The back-up dates are 21 & 22 May 2022, and 28 & 29 May 2022.

Accordingly, I acknowledge receipt of the out of hours notification under condition C5(d) of SSD-10389.

You are reminded that under condition C5(d), only works that are related to the delivery, set-up, and removal of construction cranes are permissible out of hours works.

Should the out of hours crane installation be postponed, please notify the Department of this, the reasons for the cancellation, the selected back-up dates to carry out the works, and whether there will be a need to re-notify residents of tower erection activities.
