Thank you for consulting with the Department about the impact of social distancing measures related to the control of the Covid 19 virus. The Department supports any measure designed to ensure the safety of all members of our society.

The Department agrees that a Community Consultative Committee is unable to be established or function while ever social distancing measure are in force. This may mean a CCC could be established prior to a requirement to do so by way of a condition of consent. Time will tell and will probably occur after a Covid 19 vaccine becomes available.

The Department supports Action 1 as proposed by the Applicant contacting community groups and affected landowners. To this list should be added Council.

Action 2 does not need to be undertaken, unless there are specific reasons for consultation with a particular agency in the coming months.
