Purpose

The purpose of this document is to highlight the Accessibility Management Plan at the temporary school and to seek endorsement from the stakeholder group

Non-compliances are;

- 1. Wheelchair access provision
- 2. Library office (latch-side clearance)


Proposal

The current proposal provides accessible path of travel between the main entry on Forestwood Drive, Staff carpark, Building C and selected facilities in the temporary school.

This strategy adopted is based on standard practice with temporary schools usually provided under Exempt Development or the Dept of Education to have access to the commonly utilised areas and approximately 50% of homebases. These are;

- 3 x Homebases
- 2 x Support Unit Homebases
- Admin unit
- Staff facilities unit
- Library unit
- Student and Staff toilet facilities

The remaining 6 x Homebases and 1x bank of toilets can only be accessed by separate stairs, and wheelchair access is not provided.



Proposed Arrangement by MRPS temporary School

1. Designated Accessibility Spaces



In the event that the school enrols a student or employs a staff member who uses a wheelchair or other types of mobility aid, that persons relevant activity will be conducted in one of 2 x Homebases, Admin unit, 1x bank of toilet facilities and canteen linked with elevated walkway and compliant ramp & handrail.

An asphalt path at ground level, connected to the elevated walkway also provides an accessible path of travel to the central play area.

2. Library office

In the event that the school employs a staff member who uses a wheelchair or other types of mobility aids and their primary activity is in the library space, then the school will provide alternative space or arrange for an electronic operated door to be installed to provide access to the office
