### Dear Mr Jennejohn

Thank you for your email below requesting comment from the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) on a Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for the Eden Street Site Redevelopment, SSD-11429726 refers.

CASA has reviewed the information provided and notes that the Scoping Report refers to a building height of 70m and the Preliminary Design Report refers to 21/22 Levels. At 70m height above ground level the proposed buildings will infringe the Inner Horizontal Surface for Sydney Airport and will therefore be a Controlled Activity under the Airspace Regulations 2007. An approval from the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications will eventually be required.

CASA suggests the SEARs include a reference to aviation as well as details of the impact of the proposed development, including construction cranes, on aviation and protected airspace in the Environmental Impact Statement.

It is also possible that the building and/or cranes could infringe on the Procedures for Air Navigation Services surfaces. CASA recommends Airservices Australia is consulted as the organisation that designs flight instrument procedures, manages aviation communications and navigation facilities and receives noise complaints.
