School Transport Plan, Condition D26

Dear Mr Lee

I refer to the School Transport Plan (STP) submitted to seek satisfaction of the Planning Secretary under condition D26 of SSD-11802230. I also acknowledge and thank you for your response to the Department's comments for further information and clarification.

I note the STP:

- was reviewed by the Applicant, and no issues were raised to the Department;
- was prepared in consultation with Council, Transport for NSW (TfNSW), and Sydney Olympic Park Authority (SOPA);
- requires mode share monitoring such as online and in-person travel surveys and onsite observations to determine whether the travel targets are being achieved;
- contains the information required under condition D26; and
- was submitted to the Department prior to the commencement of operation.

I also note that a Section 88B Instrument (under the *Conveyancing Act 1919*) is registered on the land title, as required under condition B35, and to remain in place until the future Eastern Road is operational.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I am satisfied that the School Transport Plan, Version 6.0 dated 30 July 2024, prepared by SCT Consulting, is prepared as per condition D26 of SSD-11802230.

You are reminded to appoint a suitably qualified School Travel Coordinator (STC) before the first day operations of the school to monitor transport and parking related issues. Also, you are reminded to undertake a carparking performance review within 12 months of operations, as required by conditions E13 and E14.

The STP must be updated annually unless otherwise agreed by the Planning Secretary as per condition E15(a). Furthermore, within 6 months of the school population forecasted to reach 510 students, appropriate surveys must be undertaken of the Burroway Road drop-off/pick-up facilities, as required by condition A33 and A44.

Please note that if there are any inconsistencies between the approved STP and the conditions of consent, the conditions will prevail.

Also, please make the approved STP including the department letter available for public access on the school website as per condition A24.
