Description of proposal

Staged upgrade of Hastings Secondary College Port Macquarie Campus, comprising:

- Demolition of selected buildings and structures and tree removal;
- Construction of a new two-storey Creative and Performing Arts building, providing new general learning spaces, seminar rooms, workshops, visual arts learning spaces and associated facilities;
- Construction of a new Police Citizens Youth Club (PCYC) for joint use between the school, PCYC and community, comprising multipurpose rooms, a gym, two indoor sports courts and associated facilities, including lower level parking with access from Owen Street;
- Alterations and additions to Buildings B and L to provide reconfigured and improved learning areas, communications room, special programs studio, shared practical activity areas and new student and staff amenities;
- Construction of new covered links between buildings and new covered school entry to Owen Street;
- New onsite bicycle parking and alterations to parking and drop-off / pick-up facilities on Owen Street, Church Street and Gordon Street; and
- Associated works including signage, landscaping, fencing, earthworks, stormwater drainage, and utility and fire
 and service upgrades, incorporating a new electrical substation and fire booster along Owen Street.
