In regard to your query about the project boundary for the Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project (SSD-12469087), there were disturbance areas approved by the Part 3A Consent MP 07_0074, for which offsets were provided, that were omitted by oversight from the Extension Project SSD Approval.

As explained in Section 2.2 of the *Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project Scoping Report*:


“Prior to surrendering the original approval for the Quarry (Project Approval 07-0074) on 1 August 2018, the eastern overburden emplacement was extended and the haul road into the pit was completed, both within the footprint approved by Project Approval 07-0074. Biodiversity offsets have been provided for vegetation clearance within these areas. By oversight, these areas were omitted from the Extension Project disturbance area. It is proposed to rectify this as part of the Continuation Project (Figure 2.1).”

It is proposed to rectify this in the Continuation Project. The attached plan shows these areas and the relationship between the Part 3A Consent disturbance area and the rectified Continuation Project area.
