Description of amended proposal

The above State Significant Development (SSD) application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was exhibited between 20 September 2021 and 18 October 2021. The Applicant has provided a Submissions Report which responds to the submissions lodged during the exhibition of the EIS, and amendments have been made to the proposal.

The Applicant's amended proposal includes the following changes (including but not limited to):

- amended layout and design of school buildings including:
 - o altered location of buildings and landscaping to reinstate original Majara Street alignment;
 - o relocated sports facilities to within the school boundary;
 - o reduced bulk and scale; and
 - amended colours and finishes.
- amended transport and parking arrangement including:
 - o additional car parking spaces along Turallo Terrace and associated footpath works;
 - additional drop-off/pick-up spaces on Turallo Terrace;
 - o removal of drop-off/pick-up spaces adjacent to the War Memorial; and
 - o replacement of pedestrian crossings on Turallo Terrace and Gibraltar Street with raised pedestrian crossings.
- removal of community facilities;
- removal of fencing around Mick Sherd Oval and removal of timber bollards near the War Memorial;
- replacement of electronic school sign with a static sign within the boundary of the school;
- amended waste collection arrangement and relocation of waste storage area;
- · amended tree and landscaping scheme including:
 - o additional planting;
 - o relocation of covered walkways;
 - o removal of bollards and fencing around Mick Sherd Oval and War Memorial;
 - o new through-site connection between the school plaza and Mick Sherd Oval; and
 - o reduced tree removal.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (the department) has received an amended application for the abovementioned State significant development (SSD) proposal. The amended application, Amendment Report, and accompanying documents are on exhibition from **Tuesday 20 September 2022** until **Monday 10 October 2022**.
