Dear Mr Watson

Thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback for the new education campus at Jindabyne (SSD-15788005).

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) has reviewed the Aviation Safeguarding Assessment and has no major issues with the Aviation Safeguarding Assessment Report and no objections to the proposed development.

Regarding NASF Guideline C: Managing the Risk of Wildlife Strikes in the Vicinity of Airports, additional advice on bird strike hazards is available in CASA's Advisory Circular [AC 139-26\(0\)](#). It is noted that the Landscape Report advocates 'Bird attracting vegetation'. It is acknowledged that attempts to control bird populations in the vicinity of the Jindabyne Aerodrome would be futile, and that the number of aircraft movements is low. However, from an aviation safety perspective, CASA would normally recommend that vegetation selection should consider species that are less attractive to birds and bats. CASA also recommends waste, especially food items, should be stored in closed containers.
