


Figure 2 - Hydroline Spatial Data as sourced from the Waterfront Land eTool, showing no on-site watercourses.




Figure 3 - North West Growth Centre - Biodiversity Certification (source: www.environment.nsw.gov.au)




Figure 4 - Native Vegetation Protection Map (NVP_005) showing Existing Native Vegetation (ENV) & Native Vegetation Protection Area SEPP (2006) (Source: planningportal.nsw.gov.au)

We further confirm that the property does not contain any waterfront land (figure 2) as defined under the *Water Management Act (2000)* and by the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR) and therefore does not require referral for general terms of approval.

We have undertaken a review of the site to determine if the land is biodiversity certified (figure 3) under the *State Environmental Protection Policy (2006) Sydney Growth Centres* and therefore does not require further assessment of impacts under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act (2016*).

We have undertaken a review of the Native Vegetation Protection Map as mapped within *State Environmental Protection Policy (2006) Sydney Growth Centres* and confirm that as the site is not mapped as ENV or NVPA, native vegetation development controls do not apply in accordance with regarding *clauses 6.3 - 6.4 of Appendix 12 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Sydney Region Growth Centres) 2006 (Growth Centres SEPP).*
