I refer to your request to the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) seeking comments regarding the Environmental Impact Statement for the above project received by the EPA on the 8 July 2022.

Based on the information provided, the EPA has no comment on this project and no further consultation is required. This is because:

- the project does not constitute a Scheduled Activity under Schedule 1 of the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 (POEO Act) and so, will not require an Environment Protection Licence under this Act,
- the project is not being undertaken by or on behalf of a NSW Public Authority, nor are there activities for which the EPA is the appropriate regulatory authority.
- the site is not being regulated by the EPA under the Contaminated Land Management Act (1997).

The EPA recommends that you should consult with Blacktown City Council who will be the appropriate regulatory authority for matters under the POEO Act if the project is approved.
