Subject: Copi Mineral Sands Project (SSD-41294067) – Amendment of Application

Dear Mr Beechey

I refer to the Amendment Report which was submitted on 21 August 2025 to the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (Department) via the Major Projects Portal in accordance with the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021* (the Regulation) for the Copi Mineral Sands Project (SSD-41294067).

The Amendment Report describes the following key changes:

- an amended project site and limit of disturbance that excludes three properties (ie the Belmore, Huntingfield and Sunshine Stations), part of the Nulla Station property and three road reserves (ie Nulla Road, Springwood Road and Pine Camp Road);
- minor changes to site layout components, ore production and the final landform; and
- changes to transportation components, including an additional transport route and improved intersection upgrade treatment for the Silver City Highway and Anabranh Mail Road.

The Department has reviewed the Amendment Report and notes that the proposed amendments would not change other main aspects of the development application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) that were exhibited in 2024, including the proposed mining and processing methods.

Accordingly, as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, I agree to the amendments to the Copi Mineral Sands Project, as detailed in the Amendment Report dated August 2025 in accordance with section 37 of the Regulation.
