An application has been made to the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces by Tritton Resources Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Aeris Resources Ltd (ABN 30 147 131 977) to develop a mineral mining operation (Constellation Mine) and associated infrastructure in accordance with Sections 4.12(1) and 4.38 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act).

Aeris Resources hereby gives notice of the development application in accordance with Section 23(3)(b) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation (2021).

Site Location: The Project site is located approximately 20km north-east of the township of

Girilambone and approximately 55km north-west of Nyngan (see included map).

Project description: The Project is proposed as a satellite site of Tritton Mine (owned and operated by

Aeris Resources) where the processing facility is located. The Project would involve the extraction of up to 10 million tonnes of ore material over a mine life of approximately 10 years, followed by five years of rehabilitation. The

development application is comprised of three main components:

- A mine site that includes the lands and infrastructure required for both open cut mining and
 processing of oxide ore by heap leach facility, as well as underground mining of ore to be
 transported to, and processed at, Tritton Mine. Management of water resources, waste rock, and
 heap leach material will also occur on the mine site.
- An infrastructure corridor, including water pipeline, aligned with the haul route. The water pipeline
 will provide make-up water and allow for the management of excess site water via transfers to /
 from Murrawombie Mine (owned and operated by Aeris Resources), as required.
- Project ore will be transported by existing public roads and private roads. There will be road
 upgrades between the mine site and the Mitchell Highway, including 2.85 km of new road. A new T
 intersection will be established linking the haul road to the Mitchell Highway (avoiding the township
 of Girilambone), and an upgrade to the intersection of the Mitchell Highway with Railway Road will
 also be undertaken. Dewatered tailings will be backhauled to the mine site for use in paste fill to
 support underground mining.
