Description of proposal

Redevelopment of the RPA Hospital, comprising:

- Redevelopment of the Eastern Campus including:
 - a new 15-storey hospital building comprising new inpatient units, medical imaging, Neonatal and Women's Health Services, and a helipad to roof;
 - a three-storey eastward extension to the clinical services building with new operating theatres;
 - a two-storey extension above Building 89 with new Intensive Care Unit;
 - internal refurbishment of Emergency Department and Imaging, circulation and support services;
 - enhanced northern entry;
 - demolition;
 - changes to internal road network; and
 - tree removal and landscaping.
- Ancillary works to the Western Campus including: temporary helipad above existing multi-storey carpark fronting Hospital Road; re-routing of services; and tree removal.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (the department) has received a State significant development (SSD) application for the abovementioned proposal. The application, environmental impact statement (EIS) and accompanying documents are on exhibition from **Thursday 2 February 2023** until **Wednesday 1 March 2023**.
