**WESTPARK INDUSTRIAL ESTATE CHEMICAL STORAGE FACILITY  
PROPOSED MODIFICATION (SSD-4953 MOD1)**

Dear Sir/Madam

I refer to your letter dated 22 November 2012 (Department Ref: SSD-4953 MOD1) concerning the abovementioned modification which was referred to Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) for comment in accordance with Section 96 (1A) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979*.

RMS has reviewed the proposed modification to increase the approved hours of operation at the chemical storage facility to 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and requests additional information to enable a full assessment of the modification.

The additional information should address the impact of the increased hours on the arterial road network. A traffic report should be submitted to the Department for referral to RMS which demonstrate these impacts and should include details of changes to staffing levels, staff shifts and associated traffic movements of staff and heavy vehicles due to the increase in hours.
