* The Randwick Precinct lodged a submission containing a number of issues raised by residents concerned about the impact of the Future Music Event 2012 to the Department of Planning. I have attached a copy to you also. Many issues raised require input and direct action from Council.

* The submission contains requests including: improved Traffic Management and a request for noise monitors for the event and a Special Events Parking Scheme to be in place on Saturday March 4, 2012 where the existing Resident Parking Scheme exists around the Racecourse.

* The Precinct requests that matters associated with the Future Music Event 2012 come before the February 2012 Traffic Committee.
