PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO MURRAY-DARLING BASIN OPERATIONS

ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING AND ASSESSMENT ACT 1979 (NSW)

Tronox Mining Australia Limited is the proponent of the following mineral sands mining and processing operations (collectively known as the Murray-Darling Basin Operations):

- Broken Hill Mineral Separation Plant approved under Part 4 of the NSW Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) (Development Consent [DA 345-11-01]);
- Atlas-Campaspe Mineral Sands Project approved under Part 4 of the EP&A Act (Development Consent [SSD _5012]);
- Snapper Mineral Sands Mine approved under Part 3A of the EP&A Act (Project Approval [06_0168]); and
- Ginkgo Mineral Sands Mine approved under Part 4 of the EP&A Act (Development Consent [DA 251-09 01]).

On Thursday, 14 April 2022, Tronox Mining Australia Limited lodged four modification applications for the **Ore Transport and Processing Modifications** (the Proposed Modifications) with the NSW Department of Planning and Environment seeking approval to modify the four Murray-Darling Basin Operations' State Significant Development consents pursuant to section 4.55(1A) of the EP&A Act. The consent authority for the Proposed Modifications will be the NSW Minister for Planning.

The Proposed Modifications include changes to the Murray-Darling Basin Operations to allow for the short-term transport of ore (rather than mineral concentrate) from the Atlas Campaspe Project to the other Murray-Darling Basin Operations sites for processing.
