RE: Atlas-Campaspe Mineral Sands Mine-Mod-3 (SSD-5012-Mod-3) Request for Additional Information

Tronox Mining Australia Limited (Tronox) is the proponent of the following mineral sands mining and processing operations located in the Murray-Darling Basin in far west New South Wales (NSW):

- Broken Hill Mineral Separation Plant approved under Part 4 of the NSW Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) in 2002 (Development Consent [DA 345-11-01]);
- Atlas-Campaspe Mineral Sands Project approved under Part 4 of the EP&A Act in 2014 (Development Consent [SSD \_5012]);
- Snapper Mineral Sands Mine approved under Part 3A of the EP&A Act in 2007 (Project Approval [06\_0168]); and
- Ginkgo Mineral Sands Mine approved under Part 4 of the EP&A Act in 2002 (Development Consent [DA 251-09-01]).

These mineral sands mining and processing operations are referred as the Murray-Darling Basin Operations (MDBO).



In April 2022, Tronox applied to modify all four of the MDBO approvals under section 4.55(1A) of the EP&A Act (the Modifications) to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). This application is still to be determined.

Tronox plans to commence haulage on 18 July, subject to obtaining all the requisite approvals and signoffs required under the Development Consent SSD\_5012.

Tronox is completing upgrades required for the haulage route, with 85% of these works now completed. Based on the progress to date, the outstanding works will be completed on or before 18 July 2022.

Tronox will continue to engage with key stakeholders regarding the road upgrades and maintenance contributions as required under Development Consent.

**Attachment 1** contains status update to the road upgrade works, (listed in Schedule 3, Condition 1) that pertain to the roads proposed to transport the ore from the Atlas-Campaspe Mine.

Balranald-Ivanhoe Road (MR67) is a classified (Regional) road. Council is the roads authority for this road and other local roads including Ivanhoe, Hatfield and The Vale Roads. Road upgrade works affecting Balranald - Ivanhoe Road require TfNSW concurrence prior to the roads authority (Council) granting approval in accordance with s.138 of the Roads Act 1993. These upgrades were completed and or are currently being completed after receiving s.138 approval and concurrence from TfNSW (as applicable to Balranald Road – Ivanhoe Road). Accordingly, no further concurrence, approval or sign off from TfNSW is warranted.
