**RE: COVID-19 TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ENVIRONMENTAL  
MONITORING REQUIREMENTS**

The Department approved a temporary suspension and change to environmental monitoring frequencies on 17 August 2020 for the following Tronox sites.

- Ginkgo Mine (DA 251-09-01);
- Snapper Mine (06\_0168);
- Broken Hill Mineral Separation Plant (DA 345-11-01); and
- Atlas Campaspe Mine (06\_0168).

This letter is to inform DPIE that Tronox will be reinstating regular environmental monitoring frequencies effective from 1 February 2021. The applicable environmental management plans will be updated to reflect changes to monitoring frequencies. The NSW EPA will also be consulted regarding environment protection licences associated with the sites.
