Proposed amendment to Hours of Construction – Comprehensive Cancer and Blood Disorder Centre –SSD-5036-2011

Further to our request for an extension of hours for the above project, I have outlined below additional information as to why this is required.

The earlier start time will facilitate truck movements to and from the site to start at a time when the hospital is least active. This is an important safety consideration as it will reduce potential pedestrian/truck conflicts on the site as pedestrian activity increases later in the day.

Similarly, hospital operations are less likely to be impacted by noise of construction work at that time as there are less people working on site. As noted in the attached report by Acoustic Logic, there are not likely to be any additional impacts on residential receivers as a result of the earlier start time and that the noise levels will be within the goals previously identified.

The earlier start time will also assist in reducing traffic congestion around the site and enabling truck movements prior to the peak traffic period on Saturday mornings around the Randwick town centre.

We trust that this information assists in your consideration of the modification and look forward to a determination soon
