Re: Proposed amendment to Hours of Construction – Comprehensive Cancer and Blood Disorder Centre –SSD-5036-2011

The above application was approved with conditions on 31 July 2012. One of the conditions (D1) restricts working hours on the project to 7am to 5pm weekdays and 8am to 5pm on Saturdays.

As you know there are several projects being undertaken concurrently on the hospital campus and on each of these we have had to apply for extended construction hours due to the nature of working within a busy hospital campus. In addition, we are trying to minimise the disruptions to the site over time. Large scale construction projects such as these generally commence work at 6.30 to allow for the site to be opened up and machinery to be organised prior to actual work commencing around 7am.

We wish to amend the hours of construction on this project to accord with the contractor's general hours of work. Given the site is located on a main road and is within the hospital campus, there is unlikely to be any significant impacts on adjoining uses with extended hours. The hours we are seeking are 6.30 am to 6pm weekdays and 7am to 4pm. No work would be undertaken on Sundays or public holidays.

As it is unlikely to impact on any residents due to the location of the work, and the extension will allow the work to be completed within a potentially shorter time frame, the amendment is recommended.
