**EPA review of Proposed Section 4.55(1A) Modification Application (Mod 3)  
Sell & Parker 23-43 and 45 Tattersall Road Kings Park**

Sell & Parker hold Environment Protection Licence No. 11555 (the licence) to undertake metallurgical activities at the 23-43 and 45 Tattersall Road, Kings Park NSW 2148 (the premises).

The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) refers to the Proposed Section 4.55(1A) Modification Application (Mod 3) submitted to the Department of Environment and Planning and forwarded to the EPA for comment on 27 February 2019.

The EPA has reviewed the proposed modifications and supporting documentation and advises that we have no comment regarding the following proposed changes:

- An increase in the height of an awning /plant enclosure
- Erection of new fencing and signage along Tattersall Road and at the entrance to the premises
- Installation of additional offices and amenities
- Changes to plant including conversion of existing shear, construction of new conveyor and relocation of pre-shredder

In relation to the extension of operational hours for cleaning and maintenance the EPA has no objection to this proposed change but recommends that Sell & Parker be reminded that the delivery of material to the premises may only occur between 6am to 9pm Monday to Saturday.

The EPA provides the following comments in regards to the proposed **administrative changes for the discharge of wastewater**

- There is no water discharge criteria listed on the licence.
- To date, no licence variation has been submitted to the EPA to permit water discharge to Breakfast Creek.
