We the undersigned, being residents of the above retirement village, wish to register our **objection** to this application. Our amenity has been abused, and our twilight years lifestyle has deteriorated in later years, by increase of noise and dust from vehicles using our street, old Maitland Rd. We have noticed it has worsened in later years. Enquiries reveal that 5 times greater tonnage of Nitrate has been stored, than the original Developement legally allowed. This may explain the increase. We don't believe we should be subject to the noise and air pollution described. Drainage and water & other liquid pollution, has not been addressed and proximity of diesel fuel and forklift gas bottles are a hazard. Vandalism is prevalent, with no 24 hr surveilence, is a possible recipe for an explosion. Although our enquiries conclude explosion is unlikely, if such an event occurred, the result would be horrific. Other concerns are, decomposition of the chemical, plus the hazard in the event of a bushfire. Possible pollution of the runoff water to the adjacent wetland. We have concerns also about spillage and contamination, during transfer of product. We have no confidence that tonnage will be kept to permissive levels, due to previous record of this company.
