

Request to the Planning Assessment Commission Mandalong Southern Extension Project

Section 23D of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*
Clauses 268R and 268V of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Regulation 2000*

I, the Minister for Planning, request the Planning Assessment Commission to:

1. Carry out a review of the Mandalong Southern Extension Project, and:
 - a) consider the EIS for the project, the issues raised in submissions, the formal responses to submissions, the Department of Planning and Environment's preliminary assessment report, and any other relevant information provided on the proposed development during the course of the review;
 - b) assess the merits of the project as a whole, paying particular attention to the potential subsidence-related impacts of the project;
 - c) apply all relevant NSW Government policies in those considerations and to that assessment; and
 - d) provide recommendations on any reasonable and feasible measures that could be implemented to avoid and/or reduce the potential impacts of the project.
2. Conduct public hearings on the project no later than 30 January 2015.
3. Complete the review by 3 April 2015, unless the Secretary of the Department of Planning and Environment agrees otherwise.
