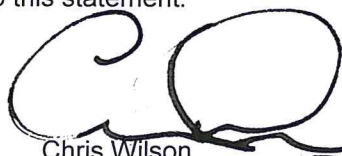


Concurrence of the Director-General

State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Development) 2005
