


- MAIN ENTRY The main entry forecourt is a high quality landscape space which offers seating, planting and a paved active area.
- 2 MAIN ENTRY CONTINUATION The continuation of the entry forecourt across the road is aimed at providing the public with an informal gathering space in close proximity to the main entry and the carpark. This space contains a large seating platform under existing trees and lawn areas.
- SECRET GARDEN This courtyard is not accessible to the public and therefore it is a 'secret garden'. It is primarily viewed from windows above the space and is heavily planted.
- 4 CARPARK The carpark is spatially divided using a mixture of tree species and forms. Two pedestrian ways provide a safe connection to the main north/south site pathway.
- RECREATION AREA The connecting roads to the north and to the west expose the existing recreation area through proximity and tree removal. To maintain privacy there is mass planting and a native tree grove.
- 6 INTERNAL COURTYARD This courtyard is accessible from both sides of the hospital and features moveable planters with trees, garden beds, paved areas and seating for both staff and public.
