

Notice of an Application to Modify Development Consent

An application has been made to the Minister for Planning and Homes by Australian Strategic Materials (Holdings) Ltd (ABN 51 091 489 511) to modify State Significant Development Consent 5251 for the Dubbo Project (formerly the Dubbo Zirconia Mine). Australian Strategic Materials (Holdings) Ltd gives notice of the application for Modification 1 in accordance with Clause 23(3)(b) of the *Environment Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021*.

Proposed Modification Overview

The Proposed Modification would comprise the following.

- Construction and operation of a chlor-alkali plant and brine concentrator within the approved Project Site.
- Relocation of the approved Solid Residue Storage Facility, Salt Encapsulation Cells and Rail Container Laydown and Storage Yard within the approved Project Site.
- Realignment of sections of the approved water pipeline within the Project Site and an approximately 600m extension of the pipeline to allow for connection to a water supply bore.
- Various other adjustments to the approved Project Site layout.
- Extended hours for construction works within the Processing Plant and Administration Area to 24-hours per day, seven days per week.
- Extension of the Project life until 31 December 2045.
