Thank you for submitting the *Stormwater Management Plan (SMP) prepared by Arcadis and dated 22 December 2020 for Visy P H Glass Recycling facility at 126 Andrews Road Penrith*. This facility operates under Environment Protection Licence No 20381.

SSD-5267 Sch3, cond 15(b) requires that the SMP be prepared in consultation with the EPA.

As discussed, the EPA does not endorse or approve management plans.

We note that the SMP provides an accountable framework for the management of risks associated with stormwater from activities undertaken at the Facility including:

- Potential sources of stormwater contamination
- Control measures installed to reduce the risk from those pollution sources and to manage the potential impacts from flooding through the site
- Monitoring of stormwater
- Complaints management

The key targets for management of stormwater include:

- Minimising potential sources of pollutants
- Minimising the potential for stormwater runoff to mobilise pollutants and adversely impact the downstream environment.
