

PUBLIC NOTICE

UNDER SECTION 98 OF THE NSW ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING AND ASSESSMENT REGULATION 2021 (EP&A REGULATION)

Iluka Resources Limited has lodged a modification application under section 4.55(1A) of the NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 for the Balranald Mineral Sands Project.

In April 2016, Iluka received development consent (SSD-5285) for the Balranald Project which includes the construction, open-cut mining, primary processing and rehabilitation of two linear mineral sands deposits, known as the West Balranald and Nepean deposits located approximately 12 km and 66 km north west of the town of Balranald, respectively. It also included trialling the removal of mineral sands using an alternative mining method.

Iluka is seeking to modify the development consent to allow for an extension to the mining trial.

The modification application was accompanied by a modification report which will be placed on public exhibition for a period of 14 days. A copy of the modification report is available at:
