Great Southern Energy Pty Ltd T/A Delta Coal (Delta Coal) are providing bathymetric scanning results in accordance with its Development Consent, SSD-5465 (modification 5) Statement of Commitments. Specifically, *“Subsidence - Management and monitoring of subsidence will continue to be undertaken in accordance with the Colliery’s SMP or Extraction Plans, which will be reviewed and updated as required to include the commitments made below. Delta Coal will provide raw subsidence survey data to BCD within 7 days of completion”*.

In accordance with the above commitment, **Figure 1** on Page 2 identifies the results of bathymetric scanning across mini-wall workings.
