**Bringelly Brickworks and Quarry (SSD 5684)
Extension request for biodiversity offset**

I refer to your letter dated 9 February 2022, requesting an extension of time to implement and secure the biodiversity offset required by conditions 19, 20 and 21 of Schedule 3 of the development consent.

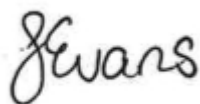
I note you have been consulting with the NSW Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT) since last year to progress the biodiversity offset strategy. I also note BCT have identified limitations with your land-based biodiversity offset, required by the development consent, and do not consider it suitable for a Biodiversity Stewardship Agreement, however, were willing to consider alternative biodiversity conservation options.

Subsequently you advise that BCT has not been able to identify an alternative conservation outcome that addresses the conditions of consent and that you are lodging a modification application in the coming months which seeks to resolve this issue.

Once the modification application is received and your proposal for an alternative conservation outcome is understood, then the extension request would be fully considered.
