


# Notice of amendment of a development application for approval from the Minister for Planning

Bowdens Silver Pty Limited (ABN 37 009 250 051) has submitted to the Minister for Planning an amendment to a development application for approval to develop a mineral mining operation and associated infrastructure under Division 4.7 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act)*. The amendment relates to the removal of a proposed water pipeline, an updated on-site water use strategy including associated infrastructure and realignment of a 500kV powerline that traverses the site.

Bowdens Silver Pty Limited gives notice of the amended development application in accordance with Clause 23(3)(b) of the *Environment Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021*.

- Site Location: Approximately 26km east of Mudgee and approximately 2km to 3km northeast of Lue (see included map).
- Project description: The Project would involve the extraction of approximately 31.7 million tonnes of ore material over a mine life of 16.5 years and at a maximum extraction rate of 2.07 million tonnes per annum. The development application is comprised of two main components.
- A Mine Site
  - The relocated Maloneys Road (a public road)
- Amendment description: The proposed amendment to the development application involves the removal of a proposed 58.5km water supply pipeline that was to extend from the Mine Site to the Ulan coalfields. An optimised on-site water use strategy has been proposed that secures the needs of the Project while reducing on-site usage and reliance on the pipeline. The amendment also describes the final proposed 500kV powerline alignment.
