

PUBLIC NOTICE OF STATE SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT CONSENT DETERMINATION

Bowdens Silver Project

Description	Development and operation of an open cut silver mine and supporting infrastructure, and the re-alignment of a section of a local road and a section of a 500 kV powerline.

On 3 April 2023 the NSW Independent Planning Commission (the Commission) approved the development application for the Bowdens Silver Project (SSD 5765), in accordance with Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the EP&A Act).

The development consent is subject to conditions. The reasons for approval and the conditions are provided in the Planning Secretary's assessment report and the Commission's statement of reasons for decision. These documents can be found on the Department's Major Projects website at:

The consent has effect on and from 5 April 2023. The consent lapses on 5 April 2028 unless the development has physically commenced before that date.

Reviews/Appeals

The Commission conducted a public hearing in respect of the application.

Certain appeal and review rights are available to applicants and objectors following determination of a development application. The applicant does not have the right to request a review of the determination under section 8.3 of the EP&A Act. As there was a public hearing by the Commission, neither the applicant nor objectors have a right of appeal to the Land and Environment Court under section 8.6(3)(a) of the EP&A Act.
