Reference is made to correspondence dated 23/02/2026 seeking a response to submissions received during the exhibition of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the above State Significant Development in accordance with the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The New South Wales Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) has reviewed the submissions and provides the following comments;

The NSW RFS has considered the referred documentation in relation to the proponent's 'Response to Agency Submissions' and 'Amendment Report' and provides the following comments:

The amended project involves the construction of a new, state of the art, poultry feed mill with the capacity to produce up to 14,000T of poultry feed per week on land at 771 Wallamore Road, Wallamore NSW. The new mill will operate up to 24 hours per day 7 days per week. The existing mill will be retained in its current form and will be operated during daylight hours only to produce up to 2,200T of poultry feed per week. Staging of the project is no longer proposed or required.

The existing mill will continue to operate in accordance with the existing consents, and associated Environmental Protection License, however, subject to approval of the SSD, the existing consent will be modified to restrict production to a maximum of 2,200T per week and daylight hours.

The amended development is supported by an 'Amended Bush Fire Assessment Report' prepared by Integrated Consulting dated 17 December 2025 (Revision D). The recommendations of the Amended Bush Fire Report have been reflected within the Amended Table of Mitigation Measures.

The NSW RFS raises no objections/issues subject to the recommendations of the 'Amended Bush Fire Assessment Report' prepared by Integrated Consulting dated 17 December 2025 (Revision D) being incorporated within any approval issued for the development.
