Good afternoon Ms Munk,

NSW Ports have become aware of the proposed Waste management facility in Botany (SSD-62855708). Due to its proximity to the NSW Ports land, we have a vested interest in this application.

We understand that the exhibition period has ended, and we apologise for the delayed submission on this project. We seek that the Department considers our submission.

We are concerned that the proposal will result in adverse traffic impacts, in particular on Foreshore Road. We agree and support issues raised by Bayside Council (in their submission dated 09.09.2024) pertaining to traffic, parking and access concerns. The proposed traffic movements will impact on the freight routes of NSW Port. Port Botany Freight Study (dated 22.09.2017) notes that Foreshore Road (north of Hale) has an average weekday traffic of 46,088 vehicles. Majority of traffic on Foreshore Road are large Heavy Commercial Vehicles used to transport freight. Any additional heavy vehicles turning onto Foreshore Road are likely to affect traffic and movement onto Foreshore Road by increasing traffic queuing. Additionally, queuing could delay/hinder efficient freight movement. We seek that the Department requests further design amendments which will address how trucks from the site can be accommodated without an adverse impact on existing site conditions.

NSW Ports welcome the opportunity to further assist in informing the Department on this application. If you require any further information, please do not hesitate to reach out.

We also request an update on the application and whether the Department has sought any amendments to the design.
