Thank you for notifying Sydney Water of the Response to Submissions (RtS) package for SSD-62855708 at 2-4 Hale Street, Botany which proposes construction of the construction and operation of a waste management facility with a capacity to process up to 300,000 tpa of construction & demolition waste, including new hardstand, purpose built warehouse, office and amenities and two new cross overs.

Amendments to the SSD have occurred, including minor changes to layout to accommodate carparking.
