In accordance with consent condition *D1 d) iii) Hours of Work*, we would like to apply for modified hours of work on Sunday 9 May 2021. This is to facilitate the dismantle of a tower crane at the Construction site during the hours approved by Waverley Council.

The day and duration of the Works was lodged upon consultation with Waverley Council, who have directed that these works be carried out on a Sunday, between the hours of 0600 and 2300. Approval for the Tower Crane dismantle works was received from the relevant authorities, on the 20 October 2020.

Richard Crookes Constructions would like to provide enough notification to all relevant stakeholders, so instead of dismantling the tower crane on the 31st of January 2021, we are now planning on dismantling it on a backup date of the 9th of May 2021.
