SSD 14_6456: Narrabri Gas Project, Supplementary Response to Submissions (RtS)

Thank you for your email on 8 April 2019 referring the *Supplementary Response to Submissions* for SSD 14_6456 to Roads and Maritime Services for comment. Reference is made to Roads and Maritime's previous submission in relation to this proposal dated 27 April 2018. All comments made in the previous submission still apply; in particular, the intersection treatments are still required, and all intersection upgrades need to be completed prior to construction of the project.

The Supplementary RtS has been reviewed. The proponent claims the number of vehicles turning right into X Line Road is forecast to be minimal. As such a BAR treatment is not required.

Roads and Maritime will require traffic data to make an assessment on actual turning vehicles before we can revise this requirement. A Basic Right Turn (BAR) is a minimum treatment, and will be required unless the proponent can provide turning volumes that demonstrate otherwise.
